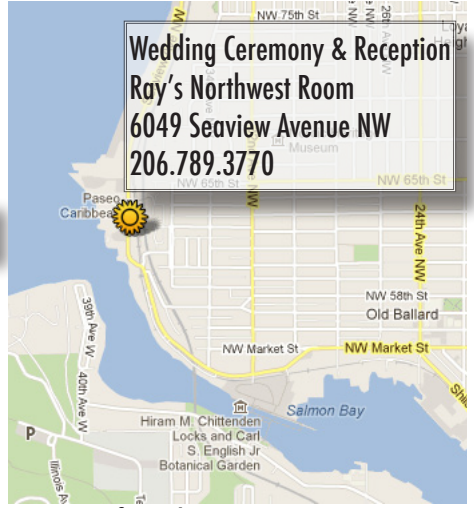

### Directions from downtown to Ray's

1. Travel northwest on 1st St
2. Left onto Wall St
3. Right onto Alaskan Way
4. Continue onto Broad St
5. Left onto Western Ave
6. Continue onto Elliott Ave W
7. Continue onto 15th Ave W
8. Take ramp to Ballard
9. Merge onto 15th Ave NW
10. Turn left onto NW Market St
11. Slight left onto NW 54th St
12. Continue onto Seaview Ave NW
13. Arrive at 6049 Seaview Avenue NW

## ❑ Downtown/Belltown/South Lake Union

Most sights are within walking distance or can be reached via Monorail, light rail or bus (buses are free in the downtown area, too).

With CityPASS, you get admission to: Space Needle, Seattle Aquarium, Argosy Cruises Seattle Harbor Tour, Pacific Science Center, EMP Museum, & Woodland Park Zoo OR The Museum of Flight. ## ❑ Fremont

10-15 minutes north of downtown. Known for quirky festivals, strange statues and Adam and Amy's apartment. Take the #26 or #28 bus to Fremont Avenue and 34th.

## ❑ Wallingford

10-15 minutes north of downtown. Home to Dave Matthews and Adam and Amy's first apartment in Seattle. Take the #16 bus to 45th and Wallingford. The #26 will take you close to Gas Works Park.

## ❑ Ballard

20 minutes from downtown. Market Street and Ballard Avenue offer great shops, restaurants and bars. Also home to Adam & Amy's wedding venue!

Take the #17 or #18 bus to Market Street and Ballard Avenue. If you're heading to Golden Gardens or Paseo, take the 17 farther north.

10-15 minutes northeast of downtown. Home to the University of Washington. From the Westlake Center transit tunnel, take any of the 70s express buses (#71, #72, #73, #74).

## ❑ Capitol Hill

5 minutes from downtown. Check out the hippest of all the hipster neighborhoods in a very hipster city. Take the #49, #10 or #11 or walk (uphill).
